

From 1874 through 1880, he was musical critic at the Cincinnati Gazette. He then became musical editor at the New York Tribune. He also wrote about music for the Tribune, Scribners Monthly, and others. His writing introduced several composers not-yet-known to Americans, such as Richard Wagner, Johannes Brahms, and Pyotr Tchaikovsky. He annotated concert programs, translated opera libretti, and published one-dozen books on music, musicians, and musical instruments.
