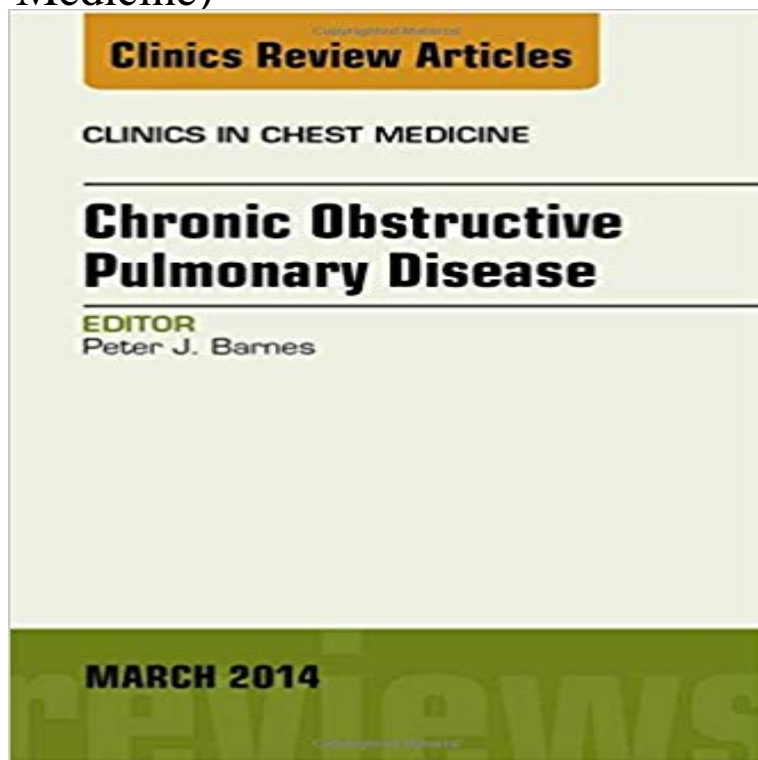


COPD, An Issue of Clinics in Chest Medicine, 1e (The Clinics: Internal Medicine)
