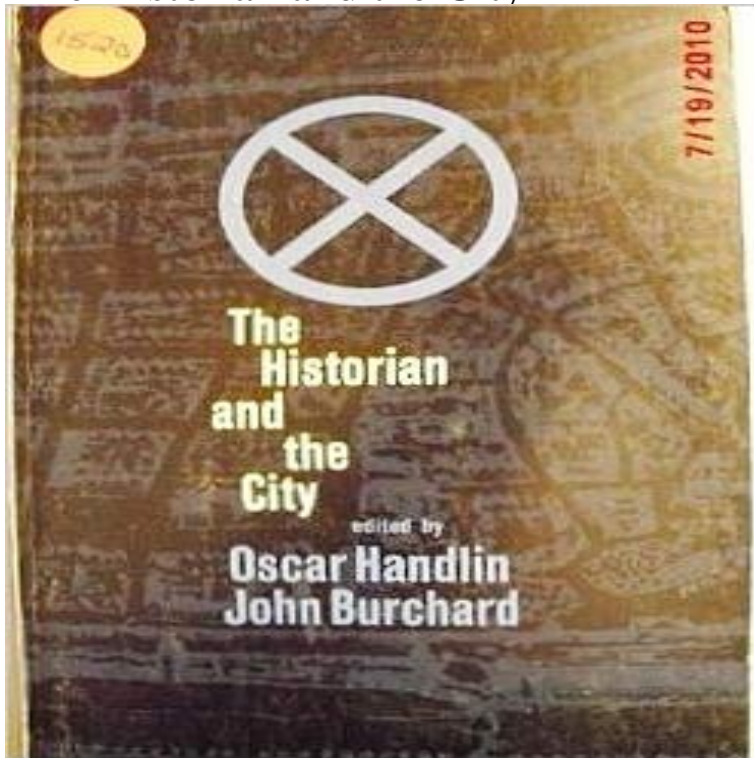


The Historian and the City
