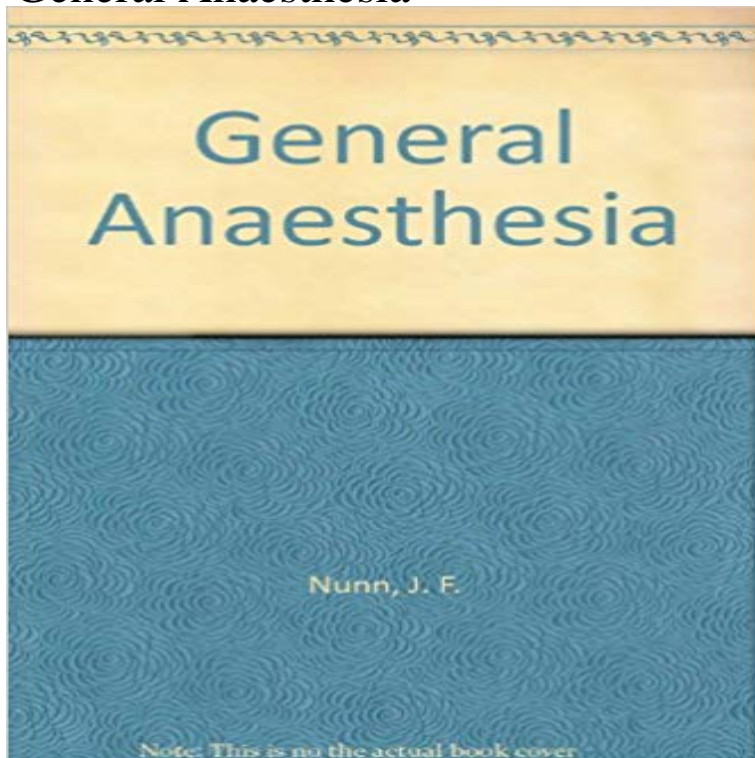


General Anaesthesia
