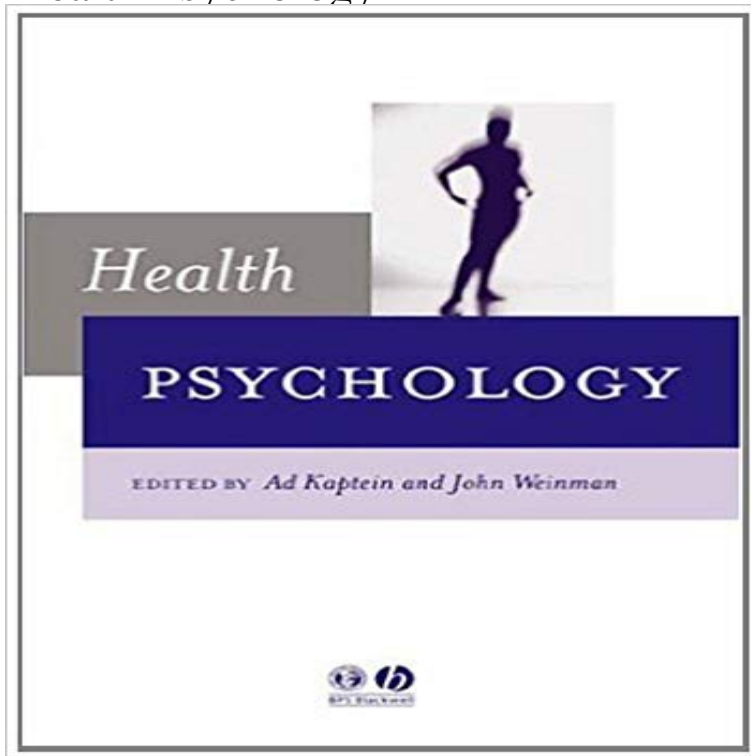


Health Psychology
