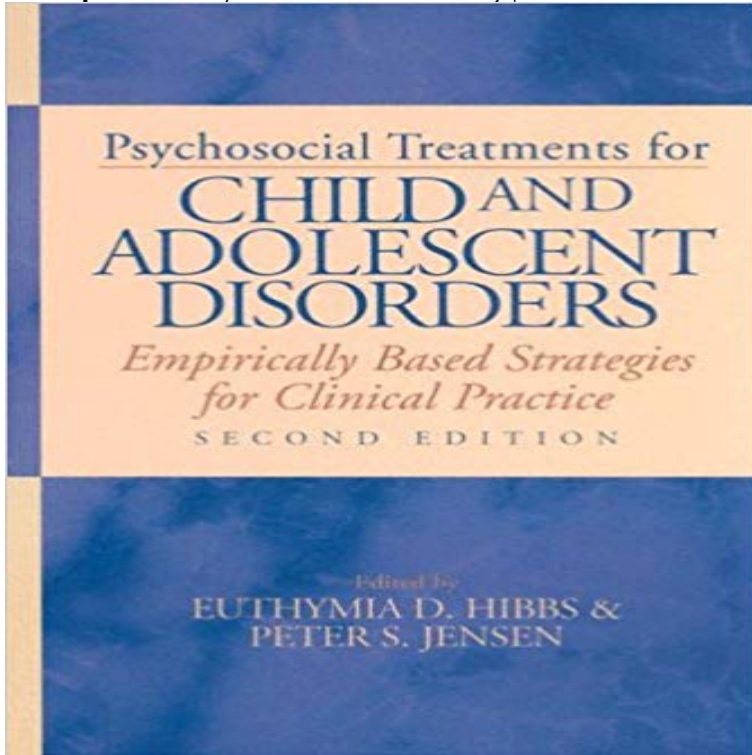


Psychosocial Treatments For Child And Adolescent Disorders: Empirically Based Strategies For Clinical Practice
