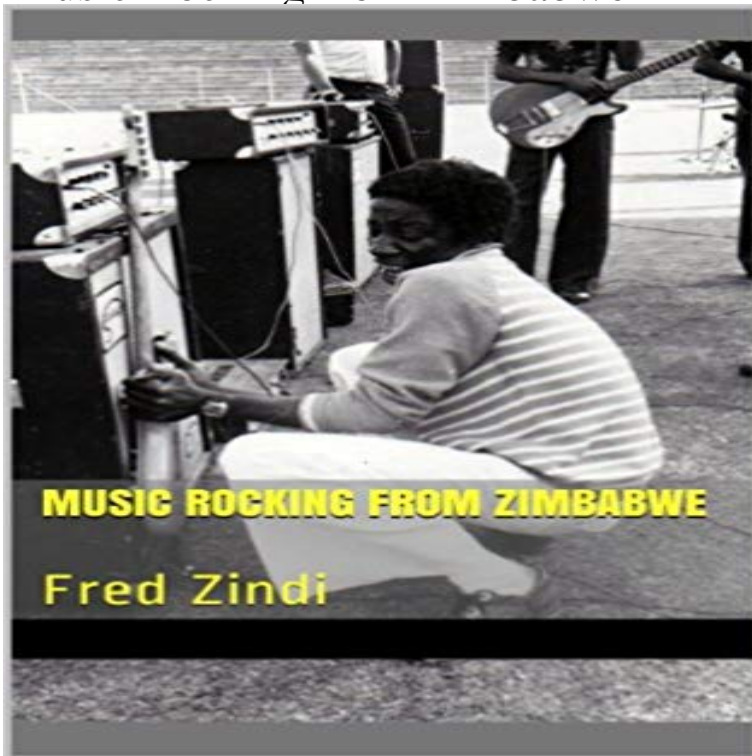


Music Rocking from Zimbabwe
